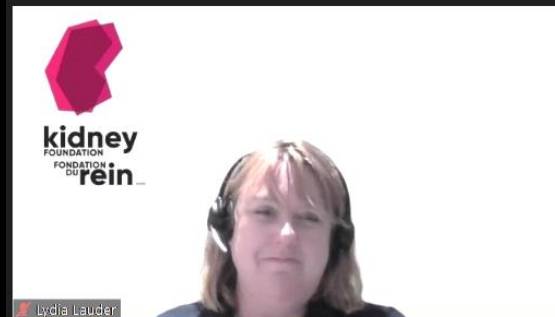

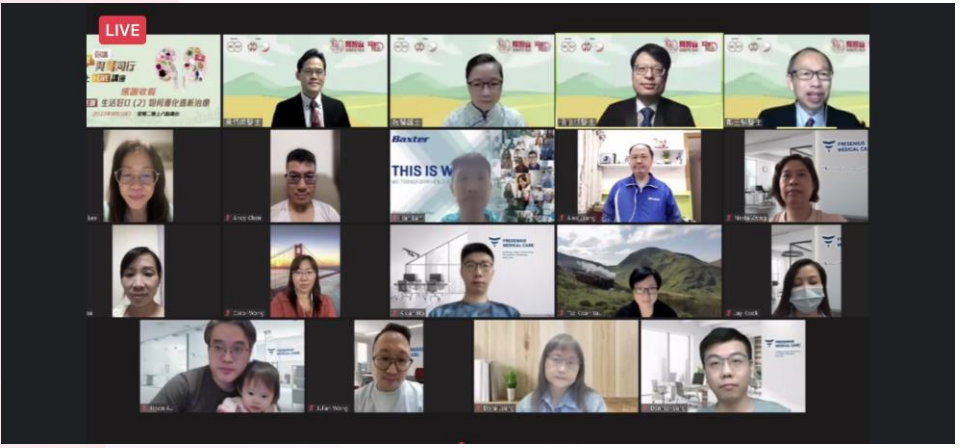

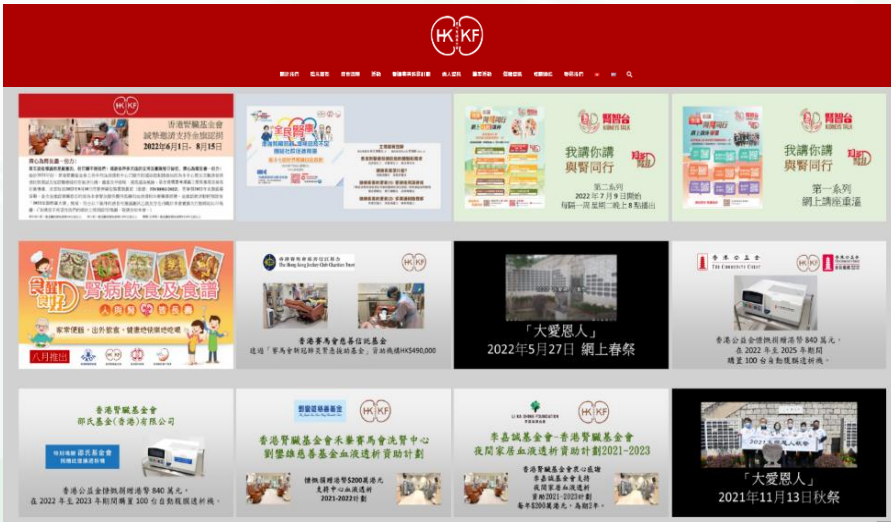

Besides medication, what other factors increase my risk for diabetes?

Many things can put you at risk for diabetes. Some factors are things you cannot change, like your age or ethnic background. But others are things you can change, like being overweight or not getting enough exercise. Some common factors that are associated with diabetes are:

- Being overweight
- Lack of exercise
- Unhealthy eating
- Being African-American/Black, American Indian, Alaskan Native, Hispanic, Pacific Islander or Asian
- Being age 45 or older
- Having a family history of diabetes
- Having had diabetes during pregnancy
- Having high blood pressure or abnormal blood fats (cholesterol or triglycerides)
- Having had an hepatitis C virus infection

A meeting with Rajan Eye Care in Chennai July led to the ophthalmic hospital providing privilege cards in September to TANKER employees and patients, enabling them to have free consultations and treatment at the hospital.

SAVE A LIFE: Through this program, we try to help kidney failure patients, financially, for their treatment. This program solely runs from donations. We receive from the public at large. July to September we utilized Rs. 1, 50,000/- for supporting 40 needy dialysis patients and 5 kidney transplant patients by way of providing dialysis kits, medicines, and support for the surgery expenses of making AV Fistula.

Foundation has set up its **first dialysis center** at Himmatnagar in Sabarkantha district with an objective to provide free dialysis to needy patients.
