Report on Activities by the Donor Network in BiH and the Association of Dialysis and Transplanted Patients of FBiH in the Last Quarter of 2024

Recognition for Contributions to Transplant Medicine

In September 2024, during a symposium commemorating the 101st anniversary of the Institute for Public Health of FBiH, activists from the Donor Network and the Association of Dialysis and Transplanted Patients of FBiH (UDiTB FBiH), alongside distinguished doctors in transplant medicine, were honored with a Certificate of Recognition by the Federal Ministry of Health. This recognition highlighted their development efforts and contributions to the transplant program in FBiH.









Visit to KB Zenica – Leading Donor Hospital

In October, the Donor Network in BiH (DM BiH) and UDiTB FBiH visited KB Zenica, Bosnia and Herzegovina's leading donor hospital. During the visit, symbolic gifts and special awards were presented to the hospital's management and top transplant coordinators for their dedicated efforts in saving numerous lives of critically ill patients.



Collaboration with State Institutions

The work of these two NGOs (DM BiH and UDiTB FBiH) has garnered recognition from state institutions, notably the Ministry of Civil Affairs of BiH. Following several meetings throughout the year, the idea emerged to hold a symposium in the BiH Parliament to mark European Organ Donation Day. This prominent and well-attended event was organized in partnership with the Ministry of Civil Affairs and the Donor Network in BiH.

Patient associations also organized outdoor activities, distributing promotional and educational materials and collecting signed donor cards at all events. Media engagement was high, with DM BiH and UDiTB FBiH members appearing in numerous TV and radio programs to promote organ donation awareness.











Conclusion

The activities of the Donor Network in BiH and UDiTB FBiH in 2024 significantly advanced public awareness, education, and support for organ donation and transplantation. With continued collaboration among stakeholders, these efforts provide hope and new opportunities for patients awaiting life-saving transplants.

India Renal Foundation (IRF) is a voluntary not-for-profit health organization working for Prevention, Treatment, Rehabilitation, Education and Research in the area of kidney diseases in Gujarat since January 2002.

Today IRF is in its 22nd year and has 9 chapters in the state of Gujarat functioning at Ahmadabad, Mehsana, Vadodara, Surat, Bhavnagar, Rajkot, Kutch-Bhuj, Geer-Somnath and Himmatnagar and have prominent citizens as advisory committee members at all chapters.

1. PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME and kidney (Serum Creatinine) diabetes and blood pressure screening camp

Our organizations' core activity is to create awareness on kidney and kidney disease among society and peoples. We have many major programmes but the First and foremost is PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME. Through this programme we spread awareness about kidney and Kidney diseases by power point presentation. On 14th November we organised a BP and diabetes screening camp at Police Lines Sector - 27, Gandhinagar.



2. 



Outstanding honour

Renowned nephrologist, Dr. Georgi Abraham, TANKER Foundation Founder and Trustee was honoured with the 'Recognition Award' by the Indian Society of Organ Transplantation (ISOT) in Gujarat, "for the Outstanding Contribution in Transplantation".

Dr. Georgi Abraham has been a nephrologist and has 40 years' experience. He is an expert in home peritoneal dialysis (CAPD / APD), kidney transplantation, haemodialysis, CKDMBD and nutrition.

Dr. Georgi Abraham was presented the award by the Chief Minister of Gujarat, Mr. Bhupendrabhai Patel, in the presence of Justice Bhushan R. Caring for first responders

A session on 'Promoting active listening & self-care for wellbeing by first responders' was conducted for those trained by BALM (i.e. clinical teams) and who extend support to families and patients with CKD in clinics across Tamil Nadu. It was held online in November 2024 as part of the celebration of Family Caregivers Month in November by TANKER Foundation.



About 28 persons, including TANKER Foundation unit staff and admin staff, attended the lively discussion and shared about verbal and non-verbal listening skills, signs of burnout, stress and compassion fatigue; on how first responders can offer peer support to one another at the clinical units; how families can be supported as they take care of CKD patients.


Mrs. Shanthi Rajmohan, Founder, DIPA, Chennai, spoke on why self-care matters.

It was a day to share her experience and knowledge not just as a First Responder but also as a person who has been on dialysis, CAPD, for more than 20 years, with students. Mrs. Shanthi Rajmohan conducted a session on her journey as a First Responder to support peers and caregivers for the first-year postgraduate students of Madras School of Social Work December 2024. The session was in collaboration with BALM for a certificate course. She coached PG students from MSW in Mental Health and MSW in Children and Families.

Mrs. Shanthi Rajmohan, a member of the International Federation of Kidney Foundations – World Kidney Alliance (IFKF-WKA), is also a recipient of a TANKER Foundation award. Mrs. Shanthi Rajmohan was presented the La Renon TANKER Foundation for the Sake of Honour Award (given to an individual who has done exemplary work in his or her field) in January 2024. She was awarded for being a brave warrior and a person who has been on CAPD long term (20+ years).

20 screening programmes were conducted in the last 3 months and 1568 people were screened.










